

# **\*PROFESSION OF FAITH**

P: Dear friends, we rejoice that you now desire to make public profession of your faith and assume a greater responsibility in the life of our Christian community and its mission in the world.

P: Brothers and sisters in Christ: In Holy Baptism our Lord Jesus Christ received you and made you members of his Church. In the community of God's people, you have learned from his Word God's loving purpose for you and all creation. You have been nourished at his holy table and called to

be witnesses to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Now, therefore, I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we baptize.

- P: Do you renounce all the forces of evil, the devil, and all his empty promises?
  - Y: I do.
  - P: Do you believe in God the Father?
  - Y: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.
  - P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?
  - Y: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.
  - P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?
  - Y: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy

catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen

# The Congregation May Be Seated.

Affirmation in the Presence of the Assembly:

P: You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Baptism: to live among God's faithful people, to hear his Word and share in his Supper, to proclaim the Good News of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people following the example of our Lord Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

[Each Confirmand answers in turn.]

- Y: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me.
- P: People of God, do you promise to support these sisters and brothers and pray for them in

their life in Christ?

C: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.

[Each confirmand comes forward one at a time and kneels at the small kneeler. Parents, sponsors, mentors and others are invited to come forward with their Confirmand for the Laying on of Hands.]

#### [Confirmands will state their name to the Pastor as they place hands on the Confirmand's head.]

P: Father in heaven, for Jesus' sake, stir up in \_\_\_\_\_\_ the gift of your Holy Spirit; confirm his/her faith, guide his/her life, empower his/her serving, give him/her patience in suffering, and bring him/her to everlasting life.

### [Each Confirmand responds in turn]

#### Y: Amen.

After the Laying on of Hands Confirmation Verses will be read.

### Confirmation gifts are received.

P: Let us pray: We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Spirit you give your daughters and sons new birth, cleanse them from sin, and raise them to eternal life. You have called them each by name: *Kyson, Genevieve, Isaac, Kelci, Trayten, Rona, Harper, Grace, Sophia, Izabelle, Brynn, Keith, Emily, Riece, Jadyn* Continue to strengthen them with the Holy Spirit, and daily increase in them your gifts of grace. Stir up in them the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence, both now and forever, through Jesus Christ, your Son, our lord.
